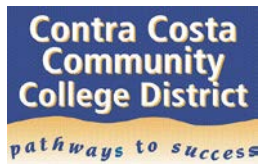

This project is a public works project and is subject to prevailing wage rate laws. A copy of the prevailing rates of wages is on file with the Contracts & Purchasing Office of the Contra Costa Community College District. Said rates of wages will be included in the contract for the work.

Attention is directed to Section 4100 through 4113 of the Public Contract Code concerning Subcontractors, with emphasis on Section 4104, known as the "Subletting and Subcontracting Fair Practices Act, effective July 1, 2014.

Attention is directed to Labor Code Section 1725.5 regarding Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) contractor registration process including registration criteria and implementation of DIR registration requirements. Labor Code Section 1771.7 establishes contractor's obligation to submit Certified Pay Roll (CPR) to the Department of Labor and Standards Enforcement (DLSE) and public works monitoring and enforcement. Labor Code Section 1773.3 requires the District to submit a PWC-100 to DIR for all public works contract awarded effective January 1, 2015.

~~Site Visit Certification (Section 00450) shall be authorized by the representative of the District and shall be submitted with the bid. Failure to submit all of the above may cause your bid to be non-responsive and disqualified for contract award.~~ (Addendum #1)

Each bid shall be made on the Bid Proposal Form, which is included in the Bid Documents. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a payment bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price and a faithful performance bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price, said bonds to be secured from a surety company acceptable to the Contra Costa Community College District and authorized to execute such surety in the State of California.

Certificates of Liability Insurance with proper endorsements shall be required for the successful bidder.

The contract time is **30 Calendar Days** between the Notice to Proceed date and the contract Substantial Completion date. Liquidated Damages shall be set for **Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00)** for each Calendar Day the Work is delayed beyond the contract Substantial Completion date; and **One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)** for each Calendar Day Remaining Work is delayed beyond the Contract Final Completion Date. The Contra Costa Community College District reserves the right to reject any and all bids and/or waive any informality or irregularity in any bid received. No bidder may withdraw their Bid for a period of fifteen (15) Calendar Days after the date set for opening thereof.

SCOPE OF WORK:

1. To provide and install audio visual equipment and cabling for Rms. 148, 162, 164, 166 & 168 as indicated in the table below.
2. Prior to start of work, coordinate schedule and sequence of installation with Campus IT, as directed by District representative. One room to be completed at a time. Contractor may be required to work after hours to complete work.
3. Upon completion of work in each room, Contractor shall test/adjust and configure all necessary equipment.
4. Contractor to provide product data submittals for approval.
5. Contractor to provide demonstration and operational training session of up to two hours to include hands-on operation and basic maintenance.
6. Contractor to provide closeout documents including all Crestron programming to customer, operations & maintenance manuals as well as manufacturer's and installer warranty.
