All other conditions remain unchanged.





MOUNTING BRACKET PER MANUFACTURER



II. Brief Project Description

Michael Schenone provided a brief review of the scope of work within the gymnasium.

Scope of Work Within the building includes installing acoustical paneling on the walls and to the beams at the ceiling, lowering existing light fixtures and other equipment as necessary to install acoustical panels and audio-visual equipment, install new audio-visual equipment and speakers.

III. Introductory & Additional Remarks

Public Safety

Currently have COVID-19 pandemic guidelines in place for Contra Costa County.

★ EADOC Web-Based Construction Management System

The District is using the EADOC Web-Based Construction Management System. The Contractor is required to use this system. Limited on-line training may be provided, by EADOC, for the key users.

IV. Project Work Restrictions (See Supplementary General Conditions -Section 00800)

♦ Work Start

Contractor may not start work until after October 12, 2020 and until all materials are procured and in hand.

Gym Utilization

Contractor will only be able to utilize $\frac{1}{2}$ the gym area at a time as the gym will be used for sporting practices and games. An updated schedule from the Sporting Director to be issued around July 17th.

→ Floor Protection

Contractor is required to protect the newly refinished Gym floor using a heavy-duty underlayment and plywood. Contractor to document pre-existing conditions and submit for District record.

Staging Area

Staging area to consist of $\frac{1}{2}$ of the gymnasium space. Other area may be available upon request from the Contractor and written approval from the District.

→ Floor Protection Removal for Games

Contractor to remove floor protection for game days with the assumption that six games will be conducted after October 12th and then reinstall to continue work.

 - Statement of Bidder's Qualifications (Section 00400), signed by an authorized officer of the Bidder.
 - Non-Collusion Affidavit fully executed.
 - Other documents as required by the Contract Documents.

X. NOTES FROM THE PRE_BID WALK

- → Contractor parking will be allowed outside North of the Gymnasium while school is out. Contractor must park in the parking lot while school is in session. Parking passes from the campus will be issued.
- The adjacent fire lane is not to be blocked. Contractor to coordinate and obtain approval from the District for large deliveries that could disrupt vehicular or pedestrian traffic on campus.

XI. SITE JOB WALK/ FIELD PRESENTATION

- ★ Access was provided to construction site (interior and exterior) with the exceptions of the AV closet in the gym storage room which was locked.
- Reviewed additional outdoor uncovered staging area offered by the District secured with a chain-link fence.

 - Not sure. Contractor may be allowed to store some smaller materials in the gymnasium storage room if space is available.
